The following service is provided to people through the Medicaid State Plan:

- **EPSDT – Early Periodic Screening and Diagnostic Treatment (Private Duty Nursing)**

Provides services to children from birth to age 21 to assist them in meeting their medical needs and continuing to live in their home.

The following services are provided to people enrolled in the **Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities HCBS:**

- **Home and Community Supports**

Provides support for people to continue living in their family home. Supports include assistance with personal needs and everyday living skills/activities as well as access to the community.



- **Supported Living Services**

Provides support for people living alone in the community who require minimal support. Supports include assistance with activities of daily living and accessing places in the community such as the doctor, grocery, bank, etc.

- **In-Home Nursing Respite**

Provides temporary, periodic relief to caregivers. People receiving In-Home Nursing Respite must require skilled nursing services per a physician statement.

Services are provided by qualified, professional Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses, and Direct Support Professionals.

- Staff Undergo extensive screening to ensure they have the experience and knowledge required to support people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Screening includes an FBI certified background check, Child Abuse and Registry Check, reference verifications and CPR Certification.
